"Grab & Go" covered dining areas

The growing trend of schools choosing to provide a more flexible meal service across all times of the day through cashless catering and kiosk outlets reduces the pressure on indoor areas and alleviates difficulties with rotating multiple sittings indoors.

The "Panini effect" is extremely popular with the mobile generation of pupils who have developed a preference for food on the go, staple favourites, sharing and socialising.

This type of service is more effective when provided with a covered queuing and seating area.

To complement the launch of new "Grab & Go" food services at the beginning of the 2019/20 school year Aquila installed two large seating shelters at Wollaton Bluecoat Academy, Nottingham and Bexhill Academy, East Sussex.

These canopies provide weather protection for pupils upon leaving the school building and while queuing at kiosks.

Creating a large covered seating area also ensures this type of service can be contained to a specific area.



- Fully manufactured in the UK to exacting standards of workmanship with a 10-year warranty
- 2-pack etched powder coated alloy frame in any colour
- Architectural PVC coated polyester fabric (590 grams) in a choice of 40 colours
- High tensile and tear strengths
- Colour fast

- Finished both sides easily cleaned

- Wind performance 64 mph (force 10)

- The roof frame will support 1 tonne which is ample for additional light and heating should it be required.

- Maintenance of the canopies is very easy and we recommend a hose down using a low-pressure hose and mild detergent once a year

Wall panels are also available as an option. These can be fitted easily when required to create an outdoor all-weather area and when not in use folded and stowed away in a cupboard.
